

**Chanceford Township, York County
Board of Supervisors Monthly Meeting**

MEETING DATE AND TIME: November 23, 2020 7:00 p.m.

Kent Heffner opened the Chanceford Township Board of Supervisors meeting at 7:00 p.m. in the Community Building, 33 Muddy Creek Forks Rd., Brogue, PA. He led those in attendance in the pledge to the flag.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

David Warner made a motion to approve the minutes of November 9, 2020 as written. Seconded by, Eric Bacon motion carried unanimously.

Kent Heffner announced there was an Executive Session held on November 20, 2020 at 12:15 pm. Those in attendance were Eric Bacon, David Warner, Tim Bupp.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Kerry Posey was present to discuss letters he and his father Wilbur Posey received from the Township regarding their properties. The Board asked Mr. Posey to contact Jeff Koons regarding the letters and explain their situation, the board also recommended contacting Stan Saylor's office regarding the titling issue with the vehicles.

COORESPONDENCE/COMMUNICATION/BUSINESS

There was a discussion regarding the Southern York County EMS, Inc. contract renewal. As of November 23, 2020 Chanceford Township did not receive a letter or physical contract from Southern York County EMS. Laura Taylor stated verbally, the contract with Southern York County EMS deadline is December 4, 2020. Proposed contract is a three (3) year contract, \$31.30 per capita, with a three percent (3%) yearly increase, which includes two (2) locations. If contract is not approved the contract will be terminated as of December 31, 2020. A 90-day notice will be given to the State of Pennsylvania with a last service date of April 1, 2021 per Laura Taylor. Kent Heffner made a motion not to approve the three (3) year contract with Southern York County EMS. Seconded by, David Warner motion carried unanimously. David Warner made a motion that the lease for the Township Building with Southern York County EMS will end concurrent with the last day of service. Seconded by, Kent Heffner motion carried unanimously.

The Township received notification from Penn Waste effective January 1, 2021 they are terminating their recycling program. Residents will receive notification in their next billing.
