AN ORDINANCE TO CONTROL PARKING ON STREET AND ROAD RIGHTS-OF-WAY WITHIN CHANCEFORD TOWNSHIP, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA TO BE KNOWN AS THE "CHANCEFORD TOWNSHIP PARKING ORDINANCE".

SECTION I. It shall be a violation of this ordinance for any person to park any motor vehicle or for any person, partnership, corporation or association to permit any motor vehicle owned by it to be parked on a road or street right-of-way within Chanceford Township unless there is, in addition to the area taken by the parked motor vehicle, at least twenty (20) feet of travelable surface of street or highway between the portion of such motor vehicle most proximate to the center of the street or highway and the edge of the travelable surface of street or highway across the center of such highway measured from the point of said vehicle located most proximate to the center of the highway to the point on the edge of the travelable surface of such street or highway located across the center of the highway from the motor vehicle but at a point most proximate to such motor vehicle.

SECTION II. It shall be a further violation of this ordinance for any person to park a motor vehicle or for any person, partnership, corporation or association to permit a motor vehicle owned by it to be parked or remain parked on any portion of a right-of-way of a street or highway in Chanceford Township, York County, Pennsylvania at a time when there is snow on the travelable surface of such street or highway or any portion thereof within one hundred (100) feet of such parked motor vehicle.

SECTION III. It shall be a further violation of this ordinance for any person to park any motor vehicle or for any person, corporation, partnership or association to permit any motor vehicle owned by it to be parked within any street or highway right-ofway within Chanceford Township at a location less than twenty-five (25) feet from any street or driveway intersecting such street or highway on the same side of the street as the parked vehicle is located.

SECTION IV. In the event a motor vehicle is parked on a highway right-of-way in violation of either Section I or Section II of this ordinance, the Township Board of Supervisors shall have the right to cause the removal of such motor vehicle to a place designated by the Township and prior to the owner of such motor vehicle regaining possession of such vehicle, such owner shall pay to the Township the costs incurred by Township in causing such removal and storage and, in addition thereto, pay to Township the penalty described by this ordinance.

SECTION V. Chanceford Township, its employees and contractors shall have no liability for any damage to any motor vehicle parked in violation of this ordinance occurring to such motor vehicle by reason of Township's removal of such vehicle from its parking location and/or by reason of the Township's road maintenance and/or snow removal equipment colliding with such motor vehicle.

SECTION VI. Any person, corporation, partnership, or association found in violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof by a

District Magistrate, be sentenced to pay a penalty of six hundred (\$600.00) dollars. Each and every day that parking continues in violation of any provision of this ordinance shall constitute a separate and distinct offense and shall be subject to separate and distinct penalties hereunder.

SECTION VII. This ordinance shall be known as the "Chanceford Township Parking Ordinance".
